

How high should the classroom electrical distribution box be installed



Article Overview

The recommended installation height for a classroom electrical distribution box is typically between 1.4 meters (4.5 feet) and 1.7 meters (5.5 feet) from the floor, ensuring accessibility, safety, and compliance with standards.

Recommended Height

For indoor classroom settings, mounting the distribution box at 1.4–1.7 meters (4.5–5.5 feet) from the floor is ideal. This height allows easy access for teachers or maintenance personnel without excessive bending or stretching, while keeping the box out of reach of young children . According to NEC guidelines, panelboards should not exceed 2 meters (6 ft 7 in) above the floor, and the working space in front of the panel must remain clear . IEC and BS 7671 standards also recommend a height range of 1–1.8 meters, with 1.3 meters suggested for accessibility to elderly or handicapped users .

Placement Considerations

- **Dry and ventilated area:** Install the box away from sinks, water sources, or damp areas to prevent electrical hazards .
- **Clearance:** Ensure sufficient working space around the box for maintenance and emergency access, as required by BS 7671 and IEC 61439 .
- **Ergonomics:** Position the box so that labels and breakers are easily readable and operable without strain
