Determining the Number of Circuits

1. **Load Calculation:** You must calculate the total electrical load of your building, including lighting, appliances, HVAC, and specialized equipment. Group loads into categories such as resistive (heaters), inductive (motors), and capacitive (electronics) to estimate peak demand accurately. Use diversity factors because not all devices operate simultaneously, and always include a safety margin to prevent overloads.
2. **Dedicated Circuits:** Certain critical devices require dedicated circuits to avoid tripping breakers. Examples include furnaces, sump pumps, medical equipment, large kitchen appliances, and EV chargers. Each of these should have its own circuit.
3. **Circuit Grouping:** Group circuits logically to prevent overloading. For instance, avoid placing a fridge and toaster oven on the same circuit. Home offices, kitchens, and entertainment areas often need multiple circuits due to high simultaneous usage.
4. **Future-Proofing:** Leave extra space in the distribution box for future expansion, such as solar panels, additional appliances, or smart home devices. A common recommendation is to add 20% more circuit spaces than currently needed.
5. **Compliance with Codes:** Follow local electrical codes (e.g., NEC or IEC) to ensure safety. Codes dictate minimum circuit requirements for specific areas, maximum lo...
