

How many circuits come out of the secondary distribution box

The number of circuits in a secondary distribution box depends on the board's capacity, typically ranging from 2 to 36 ways, with modern panels often exceeding 42 circuits if designed for higher loads.

Understanding Distribution Board Capacity

A secondary distribution box, also called a sub-panel, divides incoming power into multiple circuits, each protected by a breaker or fuse. The number of circuits is determined by the number of “ways” in the board, where each way accommodates one protective device. For example, a 6-way board can handle six circuits, a 12-way board twelve circuits, and a 36-way board thirty-six circuits . Larger panels allow for more circuits, providing flexibility for high-demand appliances or multiple zones .

Regulatory Considerations

Historically, the “42 Circuit Rule” limited lighting and appliance branch circuit panels to 42 overcurrent protective devices in residential and commercial settings. This rule referred to the number of pole positions rather than actual circuits, as some circuits (like 240V) occupy two poles . Modern standards, including the NEC 2008 and later, have removed this strict limit, allowing manufacturers to produce panels with more than 42 circuits, provided the panel is listed and labeled for the intended load .
