Horizontal Cable Management

Horizontal cable managers are installed between rack units to guide patch cords across the front of switches, patch panels, or servers. They often include D-rings, plastic or metal rings, or brush panels to maintain uniform cable paths, prevent sagging, and ensure proper bend-radius compliance for both copper and fiber cables. Horizontal managers simplify moves, adds, and changes (MACs) while improving airflow and reducing maintenance time in dense rack environments .

Vertical Cable Management

Vertical cable managers run along the sides or rear of a rack, providing dedicated channels for routing cables up and down the cabinet. They are ideal for high-density setups, separating copper and fiber links while maintaining consistent bend-radius control. Vertical managers prevent cable sagging, reduce strain on terminations, and help maintain a clean, organized rack layout .
