

How much spacing should be used between trapezoidal cable trays



Article Overview

Trapezoidal cable trays should generally be supported every 4 to 6 feet for standard spans, with longer spans requiring engineered support intervals based on load and tray type.

General Guidelines

For trapezoidal cable trays, support spacing depends on the tray span, load, and installation environment. According to NEC and industry best practices, horizontal runs should not exceed 5 feet between supports for standard installations, though a range of 4 to 6 feet is typical to ensure uniform load distribution and prevent sagging or mechanical stress on the tray and cables .

Span Categories

Cable trays are often categorized by span type, which affects support spacing:

- Short Span Trays: Typically supported every 6 to 8 feet, suitable for non-industrial indoor installations .
- Intermediate Span Trays: Supported every 10 to 12 feet, used for moderate loads and longer runs .
- Long Span Trays: Supported every 14 to 20 feet, often used outdoors or for heavy-duty applications .
- Extra-Long Span Trays: Exceed 20 feet between supports, used for road crossings...
