

How should the electrical distribution box on the construction site be grounded



Article Overview

Yes, electrical distribution boxes on construction sites must be properly grounded to protect employees from electrical hazards.

Regulatory Requirements

OSHA standards require that all electrical lines and equipment used on construction sites be de-energized and properly grounded for employee protection. Specifically, 29 CFR 1926.962 mandates that temporary electrical equipment, including distribution boxes, be grounded to prevent hazardous differences in electric potential and to ensure safety when employees work near or on energized systems . Protective grounding equipment must be capable of conducting the maximum fault current until the fault is cleared, and employees must follow proper procedures when connecting and removing grounds .

NEC and Temporary Power Considerations

The National Electrical Code (NEC) Article 590 governs temporary installations on construction sites. It requires that all temporary wiring, including distribution boxes, comply with grounding and bonding requirements outlined in NEC Article 250. This includes connecting metal enclosures and conduits to a grounding electrode system and ensuring continuity of the equipment grounding conductor . Ground-fault circuit interrupters (GFCIs) are also required for many temporary receptacles to protect personnel from shock hazards
