

How to calculate the number of fiber optic distribution boxes

The number of fiber optic distribution boxes is calculated by dividing the total number of fiber terminations by the port capacity of each box, while accounting for future expansion and spare fibers.

Step 1: Determine Total Fiber Terminations

Start by calculating the total number of fiber connections required in your network. This includes all fibers running from the central office or distribution hub to end users, such as homes or businesses in an FTTH deployment. Include both active connections and spare fibers reserved for future expansion, typically 20-30% extra to avoid early shortages (FS.com) .

Step 2: Select Fiber Distribution Box Capacity

Choose an FDB with a port count that matches your network needs. Common FDB configurations support 8, 16, 24, 48, or 96 fiber ports. Higher core counts increase distribution capacity but also add complexity in cable management (Holight Optic) . Consider whether the box will be installed indoors or outdoors, as outdoor boxes require higher IP ratings and more durable materials (FS.com) .

Step 3: Apply the Calculation

Use the formula: $\text{Number of FDBs} = \frac{\text{Total Fiber Terminations}}{\text{Ports per FDB}}$ For ex...
