

How to check for a tripped circuit breaker in a distribution box

To diagnose a tripped circuit breaker, identify the breaker in the “tripped” position, reset it safely, and systematically test for overloads, short circuits, or faulty wiring.

Safety First

Before inspecting the breaker box, wear insulated gloves and safety goggles, ensure your hands are dry, and stand on a dry surface. Even with the main breaker off, some components remain energized, so never touch exposed wires. If you notice smoke, burning smells, or unusual buzzing, stop immediately and call a licensed electrician .

Identifying the Tripped Breaker

Open the distribution box and look for a breaker that is not fully in the “ON” position. Many modern breakers rest in a middle or neutral position when tripped, sometimes showing a colored indicator .

Resetting the Breaker

- Push the breaker fully to the “OFF” position to re-engage the internal latch.
- Wait a few seconds, then switch it back to “ON”.
- Listen for a click indicating the breaker is reset. If it trips immediately, there is an underlying fault .
