2. Use a Splice Tray or Fiber Management Panel Place the pigtail in a dedicated splice tray or routing channel inside the ODF. These trays are designed with circular or oval guides to hold the fiber in loops without exceeding the bend radius .
3. Coil the Fiber in Loops Gently coil the bare fiber end of the pigtail into even loops, typically 3-5 inches in diameter depending on the tray size. Start from the splice point and work outward, ensuring the loops are uniform and do not overlap tightly .
4. Secure the Fiber Use fiber clips, Velcro straps, or built-in tray holders to secure the loops. Avoid using adhesive tapes or tight ties that can compress the fiber. The goal is to keep the fiber stable while allowing easy access for future maintenance .
5. Route the Connector End The factory-terminated connector should be routed to the adapter panel or patch panel port without tension. Ensure the connector is not stressed or twisted, as this can affect insertion loss .
6. Label and Document Label each pigtail according to its port or splice location. Proper documentation helps maintain organization and simplifies troubleshooting or future expansions
