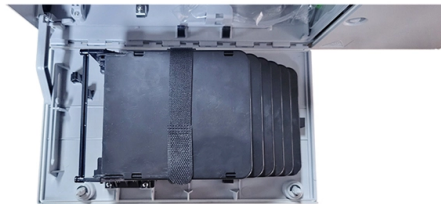


How to cold-splice multi-core single-mode fiber optic cables

Quick answer: Strip the fiber jacket and buffer, clean the bare glass with 99% IPA, cleave to under 1 degree, load both fibers into the splicer, run the splice cycle, heat-shrink the protection sleeve, and verify the splice loss.
