

How to configure the IP address of a fiber optic router and a wireless router



Article Overview

To set up a fiber optic router, connect it to the ONT, configure the IP and ISP credentials, then set up Wi-Fi; for a wireless router, connect to the modem, access the admin panel, and configure network settings.

Setting Up a Fiber Optic Router

- **Connect the Hardware:** Locate your fiber optic wall outlet and plug the fiber cable into the Optical Network Terminal (ONT). Then, use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to the WAN port on your router . Power on both the ONT and the router .
- **Access the Router Admin Panel:** Open a web browser on a connected computer and enter the router's IP address (commonly 192.168.1.1) to access the admin interface .
- **Configure IP and ISP Settings:** Depending on your ISP, select the connection type (Dynamic IP, Static IP, or PPPoE). For a Static IP, enter the IP address, subnet mask, default gateway, and DNS servers provided by your ISP . For Dynamic IP, the router will automatically obtain these settings.
- **Update Firmware:** Check for firmware updates to ensure optimal performance and security .
- **Set Up Wi-Fi:** Customize your network name (SSID) and set a strong password using WPA2 or WPA3 encryption . Position the router centrally for better coverage.
- **Test the Connection:** Connect a device via Wi-Fi or Ethernet and verify internet access. Run a speed test to confirm proper fiber speeds .
