

How to connect fiber optic cable to pigtail board

Connecting a fiber optic cable to a pigtail board is typically done by fusion or mechanical splicing the bare end of a pigtail to the incoming fiber, then securing the connector end into the pigtail board or patch panel.

The connector end plugs into equipment such as a pigtail board, optical distribution frame (ODF), or patch panel, while the bare end is spliced to the incoming fiber cable. Pigtails are widely used in single-mode applications and provide a reliable, low-loss connection without the need for field-terminating connectors.

Tools and Materials Needed

To connect a fiber optic cable to a pigtail board, you will need:

- Fiber cleaver for precise cutting of the fiber
- Fusion splicer or mechanical splice kit
- Fiber stripper and cleaning tools (e.g., isopropyl alcohol wipes)
- Pigtails of the appropriate connector type (LC, SC, ST, etc.)
- Splice tray or protective enclosure for the spliced fibers...
