

How to connect fiber optic cables without heat shrink tubing



Overview

The simplest method: join two pre-terminated cables via a coupler (also called an adapter). The coupler aligns the two connector ferrules using a zirconia sleeve. Need to extend, repair or join two fibre optic cables?

There are three main methods, each with its own advantages and limitations. It's widely used in electrical installations, but it comes with some limitations when applied to fiber optic harnesses: Thermal stress – The heat required to shrink heat shrink tubing can damage delicate. Fix the tubing that shrinks to the inside of the tube over one fiber end with the second end pushing away from the area in which pots are spliced. Do cleaning and preparation after the recommendation, then cut both fiber ends. A reliable connection will maintain efficient network operation by minimising light loss, and will avoid any problems from moisture or dirt getting in to the connector.
