

How to interpret the light source information of a cross-contamination box

Light source information in a cross-contamination box indicates the intensity and distribution of signals used to detect potential contamination, and must be interpreted in the context of instrument sensitivity, crosstalk, and cleaning validation limits.

Understanding the Light Source

The light source in a cross-contamination box is typically used to detect residues or contaminants on surfaces or in samples. The intensity of the light signal reflects the presence and concentration of material, while the distribution can indicate areas of higher contamination risk. For example, in luminescent assays, a strong signal may indicate a higher level of contamination, whereas weak signals may be near the detection limit of the instrument .

Instrument Sensitivity and Crosstalk

When interpreting light source data, consider the sensitivity of the detection instrument. Highly sensitive instruments can detect low levels of contamination that less sensitive devices might miss. However, crosstalk—where light from one area or sample affects adjacent areas—can lead to false positives or overestimation of contamination . To minimize this, ensure proper isolation of measurement zones and, if possible, use blank or buffer areas to separate high-signal regions from low-signal regions....
