Key Considerations for Choosing a Brand

1. **Fiber Type Compatibility** Ensure the pigtail matches your existing fiber: single-mode (9/125 μm) or multimode (50/125 μm or 62.5/125 μm). Mixing types can cause severe signal loss and network failure. For high-speed applications, consider OM3 or OM4 multimode fibers. 2. **Connector Type and Polish** Choose a connector type (LC, SC, ST, FC, E2000) that matches your equipment ports. Pay attention to polish type: UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) for general use or APC (Angled Physical Contact) for low back reflection applications like CATV or high-precision networks. 3. **Manufacturing Quality** High-quality pigtails are factory-terminated and polished under controlled conditions, ensuring low insertion loss and high return loss. Reliable brands provide factory-tested performance metrics and traceable serial numbers. Avoid cheap, untested pigtails, which may fail within months. 4. **Environmental Durability** For indoor use, standard pigtails suffice. For outdoor or harsh environments, consider armored or waterproof pigtails with reinforced jackets to resist mechanical stress, moisture, and rodent damage. 5. **Fiber Count and Color Coding** Select single-fiber or multi-fiber pigtails based on your application. Multi-fiber pigtails should follow TIA-EIA-598-A color coding for easy identification and splicing. 6. **Supplier Reputation and Support** Choose brands with a proven track record in the industry, good customer support, and clear documentation.
