

How to use the fiber optic splice box gel

Fiber optic splice box gel is applied to protect splices from moisture, dust, and mechanical stress while ensuring optimal light transmission.

Purpose of the Gel

Fiber optic splice box gel serves as a protective and index-matching medium. It fills gaps between fiber ends in mechanical splices, reducing back reflection and insertion loss by matching the refractive index of the fibers. Additionally, the gel absorbs mechanical stress caused by vibration, thermal expansion, or shock, preventing fiber breakage and maintaining long-term reliability .

Preparation

- Clean the fibers: Remove any water-blocking or petroleum-based gel from the fiber coating using a lint-free cloth and compatible cleaning agent. Avoid soaking the fiber, as solvents can swell the coating .
- Strip the protective coating: Expose the bare fiber ends carefully without nicking or damaging the glass core .
- Prepare the splice tray or closure: Open the splice box or gel dome closure and organize the fiber routing according to the manufacturer's instructions .

Applying the Gel

- Mechanical splices: Place a small amount of index-matching gel into the splice cavity before inserting the fibers. The gel should cover the fiber ends without overflowing, ensuring a seamless optical path .
- Gel dome closures: Fill the closure with the gel to encase the splices and cable en...
