

Important Notes for Acceptance of Galvanized Flat Steel Cable Trays



Article Overview

Acceptance of galvanized flat steel cable trays requires verification of material quality, galvanization integrity, mechanical strength, compliance with standards, and proper installation practices.

Material and Galvanization Quality

Ensure the cable tray is made of high-strength steel suitable for the intended environment. The galvanization, whether pre-galvanized or hot-dip, must provide uniform corrosion protection without visible defects such as flaking, rust, or uneven coating thickness. Verify that the steel grade and galvanization meet the manufacturer's specifications and relevant standards.

Mechanical Strength and Load Capacity

Check that the tray can support the intended cable load without excessive deflection. IEC 61537 specifies testing for deflection and yield strength at standard spans (commonly 1m, 1.5m, and 2m) to ensure structural integrity. Confirm that the tray's span, support spacing, and load rating comply with the design requirements and manufacturer's test certificates.
