Definition and Function

An Optical Amplifier (OA) is a key component in fiber optic networks that amplifies light signals directly as they travel through the fiber, maintaining signal strength over long distances without the need for electrical regeneration. This is crucial in high-capacity systems like Wavelength Division Multiplexing (WDM) networks, where multiple channels of data are transmitted simultaneously.

Types of Optical Amplifiers

Optical amplifiers are categorized based on their placement in the network:

- **Booster Amplifier (BA):** Installed at the transmitting end to increase signal power before it enters the fiber, compensating for losses from multiplexers or other components.
- **Line Amplifier (LA) or In-line Amplifier:** Placed every 80–100 km along the fiber to counteract attenuation from long-distance transmission, providing moderate gain.
- **Pre-Amplifier (PA):** Located at the receiving end to boost the signal to a level suitable for detection by the receiver.
