Single-mode figure-eight optical cables are self-supporting aerial fiber cables designed for long-distance, outdoor deployments, combining optical fibers with an integrated messenger wire for robust tensile strength and easy installation.

Construction and Design

Single-mode figure-eight cables feature a distinctive “8” cross-section, where one part houses the optical fibers and the other contains a steel or high-strength messenger wire that provides self-supporting capability during aerial installation . The optical fibers are typically placed in loose tubes, which may be gel-free or gel-filled, and are often surrounded by aramid yarns for additional tensile strength and protection against environmental stress . The outer jacket is usually made of medium-density polyethylene (MDPE), offering durability, UV resistance, and ease of stripping during installation .

Fiber Types and Core Options

Single-mode figure-eight cables commonly use G.652D fibers for standard applications and G.657A1/A2 fibers for enhanced bend performance, making them suitable for deployment in tight or complex pathways . Core counts vary widely, from 4 up to 96 fibers, allowing network designers to tailor the cable to specific capacity requirements
