

Insufficient coating after optical cable splicing



Overview

For some processing steps in fiber optics, fiber coatings need to be removed, e. Fiber preparation for splicing and termination requires removal of a section of the protective cable elements, such as the jacket, armor (if present), and buffer tubes. Many outside plant cables are also filled with a gel to block the axial migration of water. This gel must be carefully cleaned as.
