Article Overview

International fiber optic cables, primarily submarine cables, form the backbone of global communications, carrying up to 99% of international data traffic including voice, video, and financial transactions.

Overview

International fiber optic cables are high-capacity communication lines that connect continents and countries, enabling near real-time global communication. Most of these cables are submarine (undersea) cables, roughly the width of a garden hose, and are critical for internet connectivity, international banking, diplomatic communications, and global commerce (International Connectivity Coalition) . They are designed to be durable, with maintenance and repair protocols to ensure continuous operation.

Key Systems

One of the most notable systems is the Fibre-optic Link Around the Globe (FLAG), a 28,000-kilometre cable connecting the United Kingdom, Japan, India, and other regions. FLAG was first commercially deployed in 1997, uses synchronous digital hierarchy technology, and carries over 120,000 voice channels, linking Europe and Asia via transatlantic and transpacific crossings . Other major cables include the Marea, SEA-ME-WE, and AAE-1 systems, which collectively form a dense network of global connectivity.
