In a home or business setup, fiber internet typically terminates at an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the optical signals into electrical signals that your network devices can use.

### What a Router Does

A router is a networking device that connects your local network to the internet. It directs data traffic, assigns IP addresses to devices, manages multiple connections, and often provides Wi-Fi access. Routers do not convert fiber signals; instead, they rely on the ONT or modem to receive usable data from the internet and then distribute it to computers, smartphones, smart TVs, and other devices.

### How They Work Together

In a typical fiber setup:

- Fiber optic cable brings the internet to your premises.
- The ONT converts the light signals from the fiber into Ethernet or Wi-Fi signals....
