They provide consistent connector quality and low insertion loss because the connector is polished under controlled factory conditions.

What is Fusion Splicing?

Fusion splicing is a technique for permanently joining two optical fibers end-to-end by aligning them precisely and melting them together using an electric arc. This method produces a very low-loss, durable connection that is ideal for long-distance or high-bandwidth networks. Fusion splicing is commonly used to attach a pigtail to a trunk or distribution cable, repair damaged fibers, or extend cable lengths. Unlike connectors, fusion splices are permanent and cannot be easily disconnected....
