

Is the AES50 fiber optic converter single-mode or multi-mode



Overview

Answer: Yes, an AES50 fiber converter can be used for long-distance audio transmission, as it supports singlemode fiber optic cables that can transmit signals over distances of up to 20 kilometers without significant signal loss. It details how it enables high-quality, low-latency audio over long distances using singlemode fiber. The article provides practical use cases, technical specifications, and recommendations. AES50 (Audio Engineering Society standard 50) is a high-resolution, low-latency audio networking protocol designed primarily for live sound applications. We have tested it at 1000ft, but should go much farther. We recently purchased Klark Teknik DN9620 (for the second time, due to unsuccessfully doing this before) to try to get our AES50 over fiber. It has two ports (96x96 channels@48k, 48x48 channels@96k) of AES50 built in, which can be converted to any protocol installed into the AUX slot.
