Explanation

A busbar, whether large or small, is a conductive metal strip or bar designed to carry electrical current from a source to multiple loads or circuits. Small busbars, often found on PCBs or within compact assemblies, serve the same fundamental purpose as larger busbars: they provide a low-resistance path for current to ensure reliable power delivery to various subassemblies. The energization of a busbar depends on its connection to a voltage source. If the busbar is physically connected to a power supply or a main bus, it will carry voltage and current according to the circuit design. Even small busbars on a PCB are energized when the board is powered, as they distribute current to ICs, drivers, or other components. Factors influencing whether a busbar is energized include:

- Electrical connection: The busbar must be connected to a live source; disconnected or isolated busbars are not energized.
- Circuit operation: If upstream switches, breakers, or fuses are open, the busbar may not carry current even if connected.
- Design purpose: Small busbars are often used to reduce voltage drop and improve thermal performance, so they are intentionally energized to supply power efficiently...
