The National Electrical Code (NEC) provides comprehensive safety standards for electrical installations, including requirements for electrical panels (main service panels and subpanels or breaker box). NEC Article 408 covers switchboards, switchgear, and Panelboards installation and applications. Service entrance cables, unlike entrance conductors, are usually of two types: SER or SEU. SER is reinforced while SEU is unarmored.
