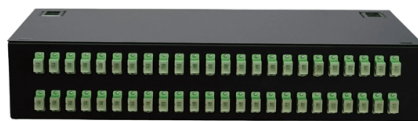


Is there electricity in the fiber optic cables of Ghana Telecom



Article Overview

Fiber optic cables themselves do not carry electricity; they transmit data as light signals, though some network components require electrical power.

Fiber optic cables used by Ghana Telecom are designed to transmit data using pulses of light rather than electrical current. This means the core of the cable, made of glass or plastic fibers, carries information as light signals, which are immune to electromagnetic interference and allow high-speed, long-distance communication . Unlike traditional copper cables, the fiber itself does not conduct electricity, so touching or cutting the fiber does not pose an electrical hazard.

Role of Electricity in Fiber Networks

- Optical transmitters and receivers at the ends of the fiber require electricity to convert electrical signals into light and vice versa .
- Repeaters or amplifiers used in long-distance or submarine cables need electrical power to boost the light signal over extended distances .
- Network management equipment, such as switches, routers, and monitoring systems, also rely on electricity to function. In Ghana, fiber optic infrastructure is often buried underground or installed aerially, and operators take measures to protect it from accidental cuts, theft, or damage during construction .
