These cables are engineered to reduce crosstalk, electromagnetic interference, and signal degradation, making them suitable for data centers, telecom networks, and high-performance computing environments.

Twisted Pair Component

Twisted pair cables consist of two conductors twisted together to form a pair, which helps cancel out electromagnetic interference from adjacent pairs and external sources. They can be:

- **Unshielded Twisted Pair (UTP)**: Cost-effective, flexible, and commonly used in Ethernet networks (Cat5, Cat5e, Cat6, Cat6a, Cat7) for short to medium distances.
- **Shielded Twisted Pair (STP)**: Includes foil or braided shielding around each pair or the entire cable, providing better noise immunity for high-speed or industrial applications. High-density twisted pair cables, such as TE Connectivity's InfiniTwist series, can support 1 to 36 pairs or more, with conductor sizes from 34 AWG to 24 A...
