Laying large cables in cable trays requires careful planning, proper tray selection, correct support spacing, and organized cable placement to ensure safety, heat dissipation, and long-term reliability.

Planning and Tray Selection

Before installation, plan the cable route carefully, considering clearance, load capacity, and separation from other services . Choose the appropriate tray type: ladder trays are ideal for large power cables due to excellent ventilation and convenient tie points, while ventilated troughs provide continuous support for heavy or sensitive cables . Ensure the tray material (steel, aluminum, or FRP) matches environmental conditions and load requirements .

Tray Sizing and Load Considerations

Calculate the tray width and depth based on the number and size of cables. Do not exceed 40-50% of tray fill for power cables to allow airflow and prevent overheating . For large cables, also calculate the total cable weight per meter to select the correct tray thickness and support brackets .

Support and Mounting

Install supports at proper intervals, typically 1.5 to 3 meters, depending on tray type and load . Shorter spacing increases rigidity, while longer spacing saves materials but requires stronger trays. Ensure trays are level, straight, and securely fastened to pr...
