Low Power Optical (LPO) OSFP modules deliver high-speed 800G connectivity with ultra-low power consumption, reduced latency, and improved thermal efficiency for AI and HPC data centers.

Overview of OSFP Modules

The Octal Small Form-Factor Pluggable (OSFP) is a high-density optical module standard designed for next-generation data centers. OSFP modules support 400G, 800G, and emerging 1.6T speeds, offering a native 8-lane architecture that enables high bandwidth without changing the mechanical form factor. They provide a wider thermal envelope and improved airflow compared to QSFP-DD, making them ideal for AI cluster deployments and GPU-to-GPU topologies in 1RU switch configurations. OSFP modules typically support power budgets up to 60W, accommodating high-performance optics and coherent DSPs.

Low Power Optical (LPO) OSFP Modules

LPO OSFP modules are designed to address the power and latency challenges of traditional DSP-based optical modules. For example, the FS 800G LPO DR8 OSFP module operates at a maximum power consumption of 8.5W, which is roughly 50% lower than conventional 800G DSP-based modules. This reduction in power consumption:

- Lowers thermal load on switches and servers
- Reduces cooling requirements...
