Conduits also help maintain compliance with building codes and facilitate future upgrades. Cable trays are open or mesh structures that support multiple cables over long distances, allowing for organized routing, ventilation, and easy maintenance . They are ideal for industrial facilities, data centers, and commercial buildings where running individual conduits for each cable would be impractical .
