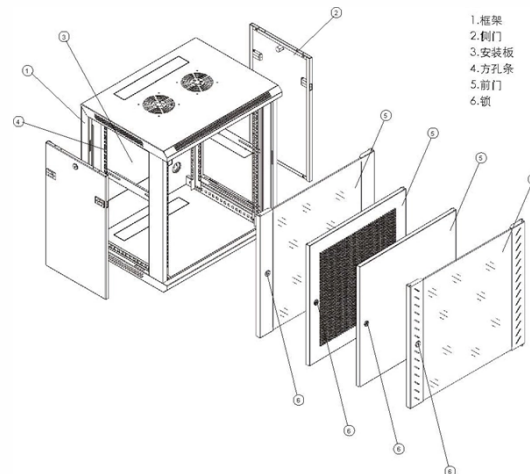


Main Functions of Optical Ports on Switches

Core Function

Optical ports on switches serve as interfaces for fiber optic connections, allowing data to travel as light rather than electrical signals. This eliminates the need for optical-electrical-optical (OEO) conversion, reducing latency, power consumption, and heat generation while supporting high-bandwidth traffic. Each optical port can connect to another switch, server, or network device using fiber cables, enabling end-to-end optical signal transmission in data centers or enterprise networks.

Modular Flexibility

Many optical ports use SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or SFP+ modules, which are interchangeable transceivers that support different fiber types (single-mode or multimode) and speeds (e.g., 1G, 10G, 25G, 40G, 100G). This modularity allows network administrators to adapt port functionality to current needs or future upgrades without replacing the switch. Some ports can even support copper connections if the appropriate module is installed, providing additional flexibility.
