Main (Feeder) Optical Cables

Feeder cables are the primary fiber optic lines routed through populated areas, connecting the central office or access node to distribution points. They are typically fiber-rich, containing anywhere from 72 to 1,728 strands, and are designed to handle high data rates and multiple services simultaneously. These cables form the backbone of the network, ensuring that sufficient optical power reaches downstream distribution points while maintaining signal integrity and scalability for future network growth .

Distribution Optical Cables

Distribution cables act as the intermediate link between feeder cables and drop cables that reach individual subscribers. They carry fewer fibers, often ranging from 1 to 12 strands, and are deployed in ducts, aerial routes, or direct-buried installations. Distribution cables are connected to feeder cables via splicing in Optical Distribution Frames (ODFs) or distribution terminals, allowing flexible routing and efficient splitting of optical signals to multiple endpoints .
