

Mandatory Standards for Grounding the Reinforcing Core of Optical Cables



Article Overview

Metallic components of optical cables, such as reinforcing cores or armor, must be grounded according to electrical codes and industry standards to ensure safety and system reliability.

Key Principles

Although the fiber core itself does not carry electrical current and does not require grounding, any metallic elements in the cable—such as steel armoring, copper strength members, aluminum moisture barriers, or metallic messenger wires—must be properly bonded and grounded to prevent electric shock, equipment damage, and fire hazards (Hawell Cable) . Fully dielectric cables without metal content do not require grounding.

Applicable Standards

- National Electrical Code (NEC) Article 770 and NFPA 70 provide binding requirements for grounding metallic components in fiber optic cables (Corning AEN 140) .
- IEEE and TIA standards offer additional guidance for telecommunications grounding.
- Local regulations, such as Spain's Low Voltage Electrotechnical Regulation (REBT) and UNE standards, may impose specific grounding practices for shielded cables (Conectronica)
