

Manufacturing Principles of Optical Cables

Optical cables are manufactured by transforming ultra-pure glass into hair-thin fibers, coating them for protection, bundling them with strength members, and encasing them in durable jackets to ensure high-speed, low-loss light transmission.

Raw Materials and Preform Creation

The process begins with ultra-pure silica (SiO_2) derived from silicon tetrachloride, often doped with germanium dioxide (GeO_2) to adjust the refractive index of the fiber core, which is critical for guiding light efficiently. Other dopants like phosphorus pentoxide or aluminum oxide may be added for specialized fibers. These materials are deposited inside a rotating quartz tube using vapor deposition techniques such as MCVD (Modified Chemical Vapor Deposition) or PCVD (Plasma Chemical Vapor Deposition), forming layers of high-purity glass. The tube is then collapsed into a solid glass rod called a preform, which replicates the fiber's core and cladding structure on a larger scale.

Fiber Drawing

The preform is placed in a high-temperature furnace ($\sim 2000^\circ\text{C}$), where the glass softens and is drawn into a thin fiber with a diameter of about 125 microns. The drawing speed is precisely controlled, and laser micrometers continuously monitor the fiber diameter to ensure uniformity. During this stage, the fiber is coated with a protective polymer layer to prevent mechanical damage and maintain optical perfor...
