

Multimode modules can use single-mode fiber

No, multimode SFP modules are not compatible with single-mode fiber due to core size and wavelength mismatches, which cause high signal loss and unreliable links.

Core Differences and Light Transmission

Multimode fiber (MMF) has a larger core of 50–62.5 μm , while single-mode fiber (SMF) has a narrow core of about 9 μm . Multimode SFP modules use LEDs or VCSELs at 850 nm, designed to spread light across multiple paths in the larger core. Single-mode fiber is optimized for narrow, coherent laser light at 1310 or 1550 nm, which fits the small core and minimizes dispersion over long distances .

Why Multimode Modules Fail on Single-Mode Fiber

Connecting a multimode SFP to single-mode fiber results in poor coupling efficiency because the broad light beam from the multimode transmitter cannot be confined to the small single-mode core. This leads to high attenuation, modal noise, and frequent link drops, making the connection unreliable . Even if connectors physically fit (e.g., LC-to-LC), the optical properties are incompatible, and the link may fail or produce a high bit-error rate .
