

New Zealand electrical distribution box configuration



Article Overview

A standard New Zealand electrical distribution box should be externally accessible, sized according to phase and metering requirements, and comply with local metering and safety standards.

Box Selection and Materials

For residential or small commercial installations, meter boxes can be metal, fibreglass, or PVC-U, with PVC-U, fibreglass, or stainless steel preferred in coastal areas due to corrosion resistance. Boxes should allow easy access for meter reading and maintenance, and lockable options are recommended if additional security is required. A window is necessary for meter visibility if a smart meter is not installed .

Dimensions and Mounting

- Single-phase installations: Minimum mounting plate or rails of 430mm high × 360mm wide × 120mm deep.
 - Two-phase installations: Minimum 500mm high × 400mm wide × 120mm deep.
 - Three-phase installations: Minimum 500mm high × 400mm wide × 120mm deep.
- External meter boxes such as DCB1S, DC3S, or DC4S (or equivalent) satisfy these requirements . Boxes should be mounted to provide unencumbered access and allow for future load control or metering equipment.
