Overview

Non-standard fiber optic splitters deviate from conventional uniform split ratios (1x2, 1x4, 1x8, etc.) and include odd-numbered splits (1x3, 1x5) or asymmetric/unbalanced splitters that distribute optical power unevenly among output ports. These splitters are particularly useful in Passive Optical Networks (PON) and Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) systems where network demands vary across subscribers or geographic areas.

Types of Non-Standard Splitters

- Odd-Ratio Splitters
- Examples: 1x3, 1x5
- Used to meet specific network requirements without combining multiple standard splitters.
- Unbalanced/Asymmetric PLC Splitters
- Also called non-uniform PLC splitters
- Distribute optical power unevenly, e.g., 10% to one port and 90% to another, allowing phased deployment or serving small customer groups efficiently.
- Customizable ratios include 20/80, 33/67, 50/50, 75/25, or 95/5.
- Suitable for both indoor and outdoor environments, maintaining low loss and high...
