

Number of cores in the optical splitter

Typical Configurations

Optical splitters are designed to divide a single or dual input optical signal into multiple output signals. The most common configurations are:

- **FBT (Fused Biconical Taper) Splitters:** Typically used for smaller splits like 1x2, 1x4, or 2x2. They are cost-effective but less uniform for large splits .
- **PLC (Planar Lightwave Circuit) Splitters:** Suitable for larger splits, supporting up to 1x64 or 2x64 configurations. PLC splitters provide uniform signal distribution and are widely used in FTTH (Fiber to the Home) networks .
