The most common solution is to use an LC-LC panel-mount adapter, which allows two LC-terminated fiber cables to be joined securely through the patch panel . This adapter ensures precise alignment of the fiber cores, minimizing insertion loss and reflection.

Installation Considerations

- **Single-Mode vs. Multimode:** Ensure the fiber type matches the network requirements. Single-mode fibers are used for long distances, while multimode fibers are suitable for shorter runs .
- **Patch Panel Alignment:** Each fiber should be terminated in the correct port on the patch panel. Using a single fiber to connect multiple panels without proper adapters or splitters can cause signal degradation or network loops .
- **Mechanical Stability:** Panel-mount adapters provide a secure and stable connection, preventing accidental disconnections and maintaining optical performance
