They are widely used in PON (Passive Optical Network) systems to connect multiple users to a single network terminal without requiring power . Splitters come in various types, including PLC (Planar Lightwave Circuit) and FBT (Fused Biconical Taper), with PLC being more stable and suitable for high port counts . Standard connectors include SC/APC, LC/UPC, and SC/UPC, and splitters can be housed in ABS boxes, LGX enclosures, or rack-mounted modules .

Connecting the Splitter

- **Primary Input Port:** Connect the main fiber line from the OLT (Optical Line Terminal) or ONT (Optical Network Terminal) to the splitter's input port .
- **Output Ports:** Use fiber patch cables to connect each output port to end devices such as routers, TVs, or secondary splitters .
- **Cascading Splitters:** If you need more outputs, you can connect one output of a primary splitter to the input of a secondary splitter, but ensure the signal loss remains within acceptable limits
