An Optical Distribution Frame (ODF) is a central hub for fiber management, providing a structured environment for splicing, termination, patching, and cable protection in data centers, telecom networks, and enterprise infrastructures. ODFs house splice trays, manage fiber slack, maintain bend-radius compliance, and allow for organized routing and future expansion.

Fiber Splicing

Splicing is the permanent joining of two optical fibers end-to-end. It is commonly performed in the field or within splice trays in an ODF. There are two main types:

- **Fusion Splicing:** Uses an electric arc to fuse fibers together, offering the lowest signal loss (around 0.1 dB), high durability, and suitability for long-distance or high-bandwidth applications. It requires specialized equipment and is not easily reversible.
- **Mechanical Splicing:** Aligns fibers using a gel or adhesive, easier to perform but with slightly higher signal loss. Often used for temporary repairs or multimode fibers. Splicing in an ODF typically involves stripping the fiber, fusing it to a pigtail, and pla...
