

Optical cable ab ends in the section



Article Overview

Optical cable ends must be properly terminated and aligned to maintain A-B polarity and ensure minimal signal loss across the network section.

Termination of Optical Cable Ends

When terminating fiber optic cables, the sheath, central member, and buffer tubes must be properly secured to prevent movement and stress on the fibers. This ensures that the cable end behaves like the rest of the cable, maintaining performance across temperature changes and mechanical stress. Methods include using epoxy plugs or heat-shrink materials to couple the sheath to the core and central member, providing a minimum pull-out strength of 445 N (100 lbf) for secure installation. Any tensile strength members should also be clamped at the termination point to support the cable structure .

For cables that were not previously terminated correctly, it is recommended to remove approximately 10 meters (33 feet) of the cable end to eliminate sections that may have experienced shrinkage or macro-bending, which could affect performance .

A-B Polarity in Fiber Optic Sections

Fiber optic links require duplex connections, where the transmitter (Tx) on one end connects to the receiver (Rx) on the other. The A-B polarity standard ensures that Tx always connects to Rx, preventing errors such as Tx-to-Tx or Rx-to-Rx connections. In practice, a duplex patch cord with A-B polarity is "straight-through," with the B fiber on the left and the A fiber on the right when facing the open port in the key-up posi...
