Duct optical cables typically include single-mode or multimode fibers housed in loose tubes or ribbon formats, reinforced with strength members, and protected by various jackets and optional armor.

Core Components of Duct Optical Cables

Optical Fibers: Duct cables can contain single-mode fibers (e.g., G.652D, G.657A1) for long-distance telecom and backbone networks, or multimode fibers (e.g., OM3, OM4) for shorter, high-bandwidth applications like data centers and campus networks .

Buffer Tubes: Fibers are organized in loose tubes, which may be gel-filled or dry water-blocking, to prevent moisture ingress and reduce microbends during installation .

Strength Members: To withstand pulling and tension during installation, duct cables include aramid yarn (Kevlar), steel wires, or fiberglass rods as central or peripheral strength members .

Outer Jacket: The cable jacket is made from materials such as PE (polyethylene), PVC, or LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen), chosen for environmental resistance, flame retardancy, and UV protection .

Armor (Optional): In high-risk areas, duct cables may include steel tape (GYTS) or aluminum tape (GYTA) for extra protection against rodents, construction damage, or crushing forces .
