Mechanical pipes should not be installed inside cable trays containing electrical cables; proper separation and placement are essential for safety and maintenance.

Regulatory Restrictions

Cable trays are designed to support electrical, signal, and communication cables only. According to the National Electrical Code (NEC) section 300-8, pipes or tubing carrying water, air, gas, steam, or other non-electrical services are not permitted inside cable trays that contain electrical conductors. This ensures that electrical cables are protected from potential hazards such as leaks, corrosion, or heat from nearby piping.

Safety Distances

When pipes must run near cable trays, maintaining adequate separation is critical. Pipes carrying liquids, gases, or corrosive substances can damage cables if leaks occur, and heat or vibration from pipes can degrade cable insulation or cause electrical failures. The required spacing depends on the type of cable, pipe, and operating conditions, but the general principle is to avoid direct contact and allow sufficient clearance for maintenance and inspection.

Placement Recommendations

- Routing pipes under cable trays is generally preferred over routing them above. This protects cables from drips or leaks and allows easier access for cable replacement.
