Physical and Environmental Protection

Fiber optic cables are inherently immune to electrical hazards and electromagnetic interference, making them safer than copper in hazardous environments. However, they remain vulnerable to physical damage, environmental stress, and improper handling. Best practices include using armored cables for outdoor installations to prevent rodent damage, moisture ingress, and UV exposure, and plenum or riser cables indoors to meet fire safety standards and building codes (LinkedIn Advice), . Cables should be routed through conduits, trays, or ducts to protect against impact and excessive bending, maintaining the minimum bend radius to avoid micro-cracks and signal loss . Regular inspection, cleaning of connectors, and testing with tools like OTDRs or visual fault locators help detect and repair damage before it affects network performance .
