

Requirements for Communication Optical Cables Crossing Highways



Article Overview

Optical fiber cables crossing highways must maintain proper depth, protective ducting, and separation from other utilities, typically following NESC and local standards.

Minimum Depth and Trench Requirements

For highway crossings, optical fiber cables are generally installed in trenches with a minimum depth of 1.65 meters to ensure protection from traffic loads and surface activities, with trench widths of 250–300 mm at the bottom to accommodate the cable and protective ducts. In areas with existing underground utilities or uneven terrain, trenches may need to be deeper than one meter, and the cable bed should be free from stones and undulations to prevent damage. Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) is preferred where feasible to minimize surface disruption.

Protective Measures

Cables should be placed in DWC (double-wall corrugated) pipes or other protective conduits when crossing highways to prevent mechanical damage. At transitions from solid to soft surfaces or bridges, tamped fill should be used to avoid pressure points on the cable.
