

Sealing sequence of optical cable splice closures

The sealing sequence of optical cable splice closures involves preparing the cable, securing it with gaskets and clamps, arranging fibers in trays, and finally closing and locking the enclosure to ensure a watertight and dustproof seal.

Step-by-Step Sealing Sequence

1. Cable Preparation

- Mark the cutting point on the cable and strip the outer jacket to the length recommended by the closure manufacturer, typically around 120 cm for space-limited closures .
- Carefully remove the cable sheath without cutting, twisting, or damaging the loose tubes or fibers .
- Reserve enough fiber length for splicing and future maintenance .

2. Cable Entry and Fixing

- Lead the stripped cable into the designated port of the closure (round ports for branch cables, oval ports for direct cables), .
- Secure the cable using the metal hoop or fixing clamps provided, ensuring the armored layer and steel core are properly fixed .
- Select the appropriate sealing gasket according to cable diameter and type, and insert it into the port in the correct order
