

Secondary installation of low-voltage cable trays



Article Overview

Secondary low-voltage cable trays should be installed with proper support, separation from high-voltage lines, and adherence to NEC fill and grounding requirements to ensure safety and accessibility.

Planning and Tray Selection

For secondary installations, select a tray type suitable for low-voltage cables, such as ladder, ventilated trough, or channel trays depending on the environment and cable volume . Ladder trays are preferred for ventilation and heat dissipation, while solid or ventilated troughs may be used for aesthetic or EMI-sensitive applications . Ensure the tray material (aluminum, steel, or FRP) matches environmental conditions and load requirements .

Support and Routing

Secondary trays should be supported using trapeze hangers, cantilever wall brackets, or ceiling mounts, with support spans calculated based on the tray manufacturer's load capacity and total cable weight . Maintain a minimum vertical clearance of 12 inches above the tray for installation and maintenance access . Avoid routing trays in prohibited areas such as hoistways or enclosed spaces .
