Parallel Connection

Each box receives the full supply voltage, allowing devices connected to different boxes to function correctly without being affected by failures elsewhere. Parallel wiring also allows for balanced load distribution, easier maintenance, and convenient upgrades, as new boxes can be added without disrupting the existing system.

Series Connection

In a series configuration, distribution boxes are connected one after another, so the current flows sequentially through each box. While this ensures the same current passes through all boxes, it has significant drawbacks: if one box fails, all downstream boxes lose power, and the voltage is divided among the boxes, which can lead to insufficient voltage for devices. Series connections are rarely used in modern electrical installations except for specific applications like simple lighting circuits or measurement systems where controlled current is critical
